

Dr. Edward Klevans, Chief Coordinator of the Summer Institute, is Professor Emeritus of Nuclear Engineering at Penn State University, where he served on the faculty from 1966 to 1998 and as Department Head from 1987 to 1998. He was Associate Dean for Research in the College of Engineering from 1980 to 1984.

He served on the Board of Directors of the American Nuclear Society, and is a past Chair of the Nuclear Engineering Department Heads Organization and of the Education and Training Division of the American Nuclear Society. He was a member of the University of Chicago Review Committee for Argonne National Laboratory – West from 1991 to 2001, and served on the National Nuclear Accreditation Board from 1996 to 2003.

He conducted research on the theory of fusion devices and led a project on the development of a radiation detector for measuring pipe wall thickness. He also spent a year with the U.S. Department of Energy conducting reviews and initiating new fusion research projects.

Dr. Klevans received his Ph. D. in Nuclear Engineering from the University of Michigan. He is a Fellow of the American Nuclear Society and of the American Association for the Advancement of Science.
