

Jan Murray is Deputy Secretary General of the World Energy Council, an industry body established in London in 1923, covering all forms of energy. With over 90 member countries around the world, the World Energy Council's work embraces a broad range of energy issues, including energy projections, energy market structures, energy and environment, and energy poverty.

Murray's current responsibilities build on her past experience gained during her term as Secretary-General of the Uranium Institute (1987-1992), the international industry association for nuclear fuel. She then moved to Australia from 1993-1996 where she held the positions of General Manager External Relations and Executive Committee member of the resources group, North Limited (1993-1996) and non-executive Director of the Gas Transmission Corporation of Victoria (1994-1996). In 1997 she returned to London as the first international Partner of the Sydney-based investor relations consultancy, Orient Capital Pty Ltd.

Brought up in Australia, Jan graduated from Melbourne University with a Bachelor of Arts and obtained her Master of Business Administration from INSEAD, a leading European business school at Fontainebleau, France.
