The WNU Nuclear Olympiad was a unique experience since the beginning. All of the schedules and plans to develop our work were lifelong learning. Each stage was important to shape my knowledge about the uses of radiation.

## In your opinion, what should nuclear professionals do to communicate better with the public?

I believe that knowledge can be given and acquired everywhere, and at any moment. Each nuclear professional may start trying to explain the benefits of the uses of radiation with their social circles. Consequently, those who possess a favorable positioning towards nuclear technology could be the emerging promoters of the initiative. In my opinion, each step counts, and only the correct information can develop an awareness of how the uses of radiation are important to our society
